






The painting adds a second plane in height and then a third with the sky. However the architectonical structure ends after the windows.


The columns appear perpendicular to the walking floor but they are actually painted on the ceiling parallel to the floor.

Look at Ms. Eluard directly, she appears grotesque. Now fixate on the yellow plus she looks marvellous.



Findings maybe essential in understanding the mechanisms compromised in different pathologies.




